Her family does not have the funds to purchase a van needed to transport Bella's new chair so they are raising funds. On July 4th there will be a vendor fair at the Elmwood-Murdock Jr/Sr HighSchool, 300 Wyoming St, Murdock, NE. Hank from Wahoo Meats will be there smoking ribs and Kona Ice will be joining us. There are currently 20 vendors signed up with space for about 33. There will be a bake sale, face painting and raffles, door prizes, and a 50/50 drawing. 
