Meet the Grand Marshals

The Merchants' Association is pleased to honor Roger Bornemeier and Gordon Lannin as this year's Grand Marshals for the Holiday Extravaganza Starry Night parade. They have been an integral part of our community for many years.

Roger Bornemeier has lived in the Elmwood/Murdock area all of his 85 years. He was born in rural Elmwood and spent his youth in Murdock where he graduated from high school in 1951. One of Roger's fondest memories is helping his father in the hardware store the family owned in Murdock.

Roger has been involved in the Elmwood community as a "Green Thumb" volunteer, janitor at the school, and is most proud of the 20 years he volunteered at the Aldrich House as a guide and took care of the

grounds. Roger moved from the farm to town in 1996 and when asked what he liked about Elmwood he replied, "It's just a nice place to live."

Gordon Lannin, 86, was born in North Platte but moved to the area in 1941. He graduated from high school in Murdock. Gordon raised his family in the Elmwood/Murdock area and all his children graduated from Elmwood High School. Gordon said some of his fondest memories are of the excellent teachers and leadership in the school district here.

Gordon drove a school bus for 16 years and helped deliver meals from the Community Center in Elmwood. He confessed that he likes to cook! When asked what he liked about Elmwood his response was "The awesome Community Center where you can get a good meal every day."

Plan to attend the Starry Night parade and help honor these individuals with tremendous community spirit!

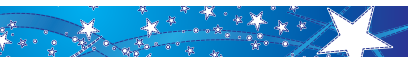

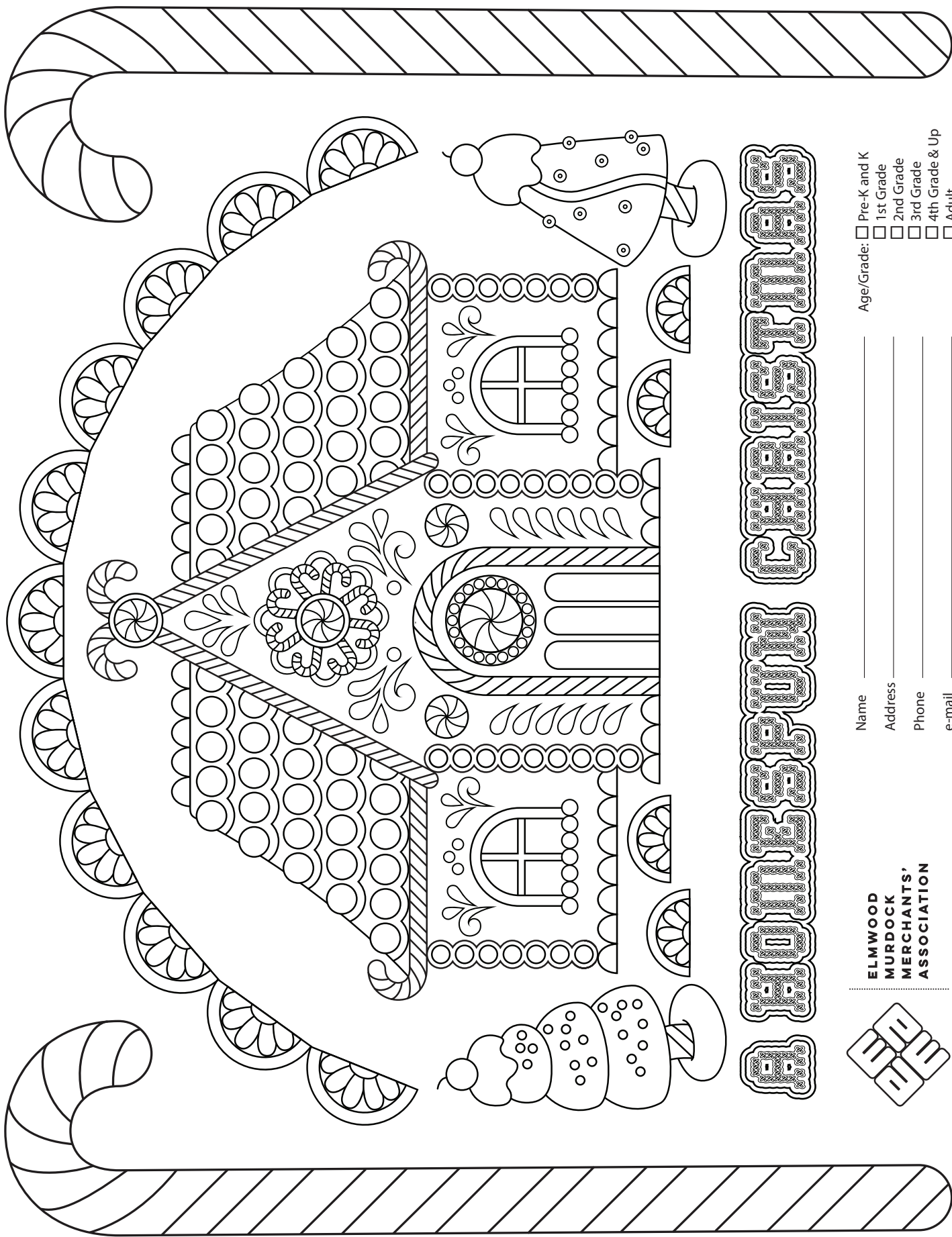

Historical Hayrack Tour of Elmwood

Rich with history, Elmwood is filled with a past of historical places and events that have impacted our town. Come learn about our history as we stop at historical sites on this hayrack ride tour on Saturday, November 24th. Local tour guides will enlighten you with stories about the rich

history of Elmwood. We will start the one-hour tours at the G.A.R. Hall and finish at the Elmwood Library Aldrich Museum with stops along the way at locations such as the old grocery store, old Leader Echo, and more. Tours will start at 10:00 a.m., 1:00 p.m., and 2:00 p.m. Hot chocolate will be

provided for you while you enjoy the stops around town, and a living history video will be shown at the culmination of the tour. Because seats are limited on the hayrack to around 20 individuals, the tours will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Elmwood Community Improvement Project

Elmwood began a community improvement project last spring. There are three agencies who have been facilitating the project; Main Street Nebraska Network, Cass County Nebraska Economic Development Council, and OPPD. After several meetings and many

discussions the team determined that main street would be the first big project that should be tackled. Revitalization of the buildings on main street to bring businesses back to town would change the horizon of not just main street but of the whole village. Other smaller
