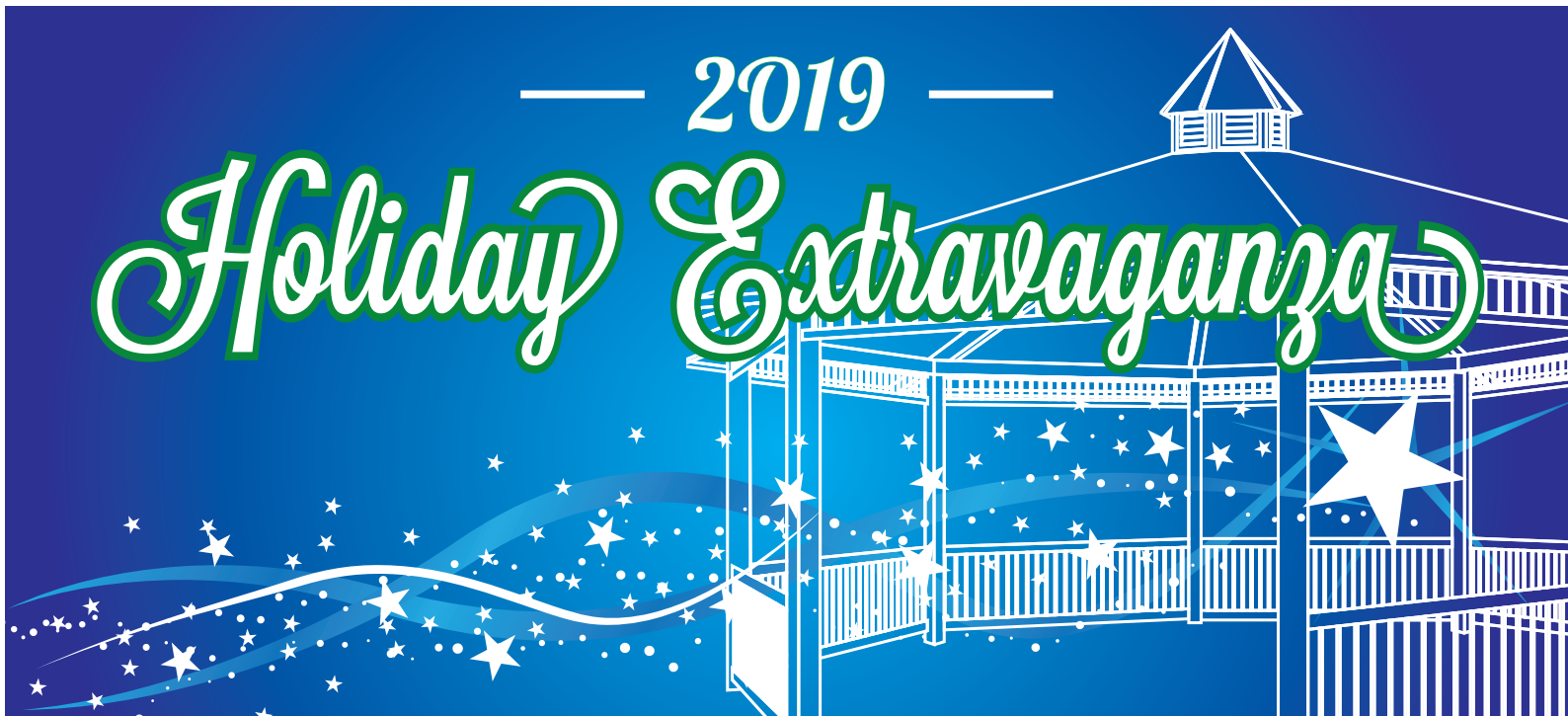

The volunteer efforts of many people were critical to completion of this project, lead by Marie Gregoire and Julie Anderson, with help from many in the community and surrounding area. Monies raised were used to secure grant funding from the Land and Water Conservation Fund, Cass County Tourism and the Midlands Community Foundation.

The gazebo was purchased from Crouch Recreation, and Heisman trophy winner Eric Crouch will be with us to launch the new structure! So bring the whole family for this exciting first!

Meet the Grand Marshals

The Merchants' Association is pleased to honor Keith and Martha Ann Bornemeier, and Jim and Marilyn Schreiner as this year's Grand Marshals for the Holiday Extravaganza Starry Night parade. These couples have been an integral part of our community for many years.

Keith and Martha Ann Bornemeier are life-long members of the Elmwood community. Keith began his career in the lumber business as an employee of TW Eagles Lumber Company here in Elmwood in 1956. In 1958 Keith and Martha purchased the lumber yard and renamed it Bornemeier Lumber Company. Prior to selling the lumber yard to Jim and Marilyn Schreiner in 1971, they launched Bornemeier Floor Covering, which they operated until the mid-1980's, when Keith became a financial adviser for Waddell and Reed. Keith served on the village board and was a member of the Elmwood Fire Department. Martha was a member of

the Modern Mother's Club and a Girl Scout leader. They are active members of St. Paul United Methodist Church. The Bornemeiers celebrated their 63rd wedding anniversary this past June. They have two daughters, Deb and Dave Whitehead and Janet and Tim Tooley, five grandchildren, and eight great-grandchildren. Keith and Martha wish to thank the community for their support over the years and believe Elmwood is truly a great place to live!

Jim and Marilyn Schreiner and their 3 children, Steve, Julie, and Denene, moved to Elmwood from Chadron in May of 1966. Jim went to work at Bornemeier Lumber upon their move and in 1971 the Bornemeiers offered to sell it to Jim and Marilyn. Schreiner Building Supply was struck by lightning during the night in August of 1975, burning it almost to the ground. The rebuild took place across the street to the north, and on the old location a storage building

was erected. In 1995 the business closed after almost 25 years. They want to thank all the loyal customers for their patronage while in business in Elmwood. Jim served over 20 years in the Elmwood Fire Department, and they were active members of St. Paul United Methodist Church. Jim and Marilyn want everyone to know how much the Elmwood community meant to them and still does. They will always feel like it is home, as do their children. The Schreiners lived in Elmwood until May of 2005 when they retired and moved to Omaha to be closer to their children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren.
